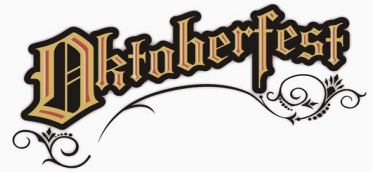

GET CPR CERTIFIED AT FAIRBRAE!

American Heart Association CPR classes are now being offered at Fairbrae!

AHA Heartsaver CPR AED Training (\$65 for members/\$75 for non-members)

Sunday, October 20th: 1:30 PM
Wednesday, November 13th: 7:00 PM

The AHA Heartsaver class focuses on Adult, Child and Infant CPR, training on AEDs (Automated External Defibrillator) and First Aid for Choking Skills will be offered in both CPR classes.

Classes are open to anyone 12 years and older. AHA certificates are available for an additional \$15 and will be emailed to participants who successfully complete all requirements for the specific course within 1 week of course completion. Class will begin promptly so participants must be on time and stay for the entire class. This class is for all community members, boy and girl scouts, coaches, and babysitters.

Participants will learn how to respond to an emergency involving all ages and will include skills needed for infant, children and adults in need of cardiopulmonary resuscitation and first aid for choking. This hands on course includes: practice with infant and adult mannequins, techniques for helping an infant, child and adult with an obstructed airway and practice with an AED (Automated External Defibrillator). Discussion will focus on actions to take in any emergency situation.

If you are a lifeguard, nurse, physician, dentist or other healthcare provider and interested in an American Heart Association Basic Life Support for the Healthcare Provider course, please contact Susie Schmitz prior to class to make arrangements to complete the additional skills and written test. Additional fee required.

Susie Schmitz is a Registered Public Health Nurse who has taught CPR for over 7 years and is a former Cardiovascular Surgical Nurse and a Fairbrae Member.
