POOL UPDATE FROM THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Members have asked us when the pool will reopen so we wanted to provide an update.

The Board has been active in trying to determine how, when, and under what conditions we can reopen the pool amidst the Covid-19 situation. We've made an important distinction between recreational swimming and lap swimming. Rec swim will have to come in a later phase as it's near impossible to establish social distancing. For lap swim however, the Board believes it is safe to do so under certain guidelines. We'll publish these guidelines when appropriate, but in brief, we'll have an online reservation system where lap swimmers can sign up for a specific lane and swim time, thus ensuring that we have at most one swimmer per lane per hour.

What is holding us up from launching this program is that the latest Santa Clara County guidelines lump all swim together as one activity and make no distinction between rec and lap swim. https://www.sccgov.org/sites/covid19/Pages/learn-what-to-do.
aspx#recreation. They've put swimming pools into the category of high social contact facilities such as spas, saunas, steam rooms, and picnic areas and stated that pools cannot reopen. Other swim clubs we've been in contact with have also expressed concern about this lack of distinction between rec and lap swim.

The BoD is also aware of the CDC guidance on pools that viruses cannot be transmitted through water, especially in a properly chlorinated pool. We are working with other local swim clubs to press the county to make this distinction between lap and rec swim and publish updated guidance accordingly. Please stay tuned for updates.


