Where is Fairbrae Swim & Racquet Club located?

696 Sheraton Drive at the corner of Sheraton Drive and Hollenbeck Avenue Sunnyvale .

What kind of membership do you have? Are there day passes or monthly passes?

Fairbrae only offers a proprietary family membership at this time. The membership covers your dues for your entire household, which makes Fairbrae ideal for local families who are looking for a safe place to swim, play tennis, pickleball and socialize with friends. We <u>do not</u> offer weekly, monthly or trial memberships.

How do I become a member of the club?

Membership at Fairbrae is proprietary, which means you must purchase a membership from an outgoing member. There are currently no memberships available and there is a wait list. For more information and to learn how to get on the waitlist go to the "Contact Us" form located on our website under "About Us" and complete the form. You will receive a response within 2-4 business days with all of the details.

Is the club open all year long?

Fairbrae is open all year long and swimming is available from 6am - 10pm daily. The pool is heated to 81 degrees. There are two lighted tennis courts with play available from 7am- 10pm daily. Reservations are required to play tennis and suggested for swim lane access.

Do I have to reserve a lane to swim at Fairbrae?

Fairbrae provides a hybrid system for the swimming pool which allows for reservations and open recreational pool time throughout the year. A schedule is posted at the club for members.

Do you have a swim team?

Yes, Fairbrae has a fun summer-seasonal youth team that swims out of our pool. The Fairbrae Manta Rays season starts in April and runs through mid July. Swim practices are held Monday-Friday, times vary according to age. Swim meets are during the summer months and run from 7:30am- 1pm. The swim team is also available to non-members based on availability each year. Check back on our website in early Spring under "Activities" if you have a child interested in joining the team.

Do you have a summer swim lesson program that is open to the public?

Fairbrae has a children's group swim lesson program starting in early June that runs through early August. This lesson program is available to both members and non-members. There are four- 2-week sessions and classes are held for 30 mins long and run between the hours of 10am-12pm from Monday -Thursday. Check back on the club website in spring to register your swimmer.

Do you have private swim and/or tennis lessons for members? What about

non-members? Fairbrae hires third party contractors for all of the swim and tennis lessons.

Once you become a member, you will put you in touch with the approved instructors to get you started. At this time private swim lessons are only available to members. Tennis lessons are available to members and non-members based on availability. Visit our "Racquet Activities" page located on our website for more information about tennis lessons.

Are there lifeguards on duty everyday, all year long?

Lifeguard availability is limited to the summer busy season Hours vary by availability and usage and are posted in late May.

Do you have a hot tub?

No, there is no hot tub at Fairbrae.

Do you have pickleball courts?

We have one practice cement court with lines where you may play. We have: two pickleball nets located on the tennis courts, plastic lines that need to be set up (if you wish to play on the tennis court) and paddles and balls that are available for member use.

What kind of social events do you have at the club?

Fairbrae has events running all year long. Our summer season opens Memorial Weekend and ends the Sunday of Labor Day. Here's a sneak peek at some of the events on our social calendar: 4th of July Chili Cook Off, Summer Olympics, Children's Carnival, Labor Day BBQ, Oktoberfest, Halloween Party, Holiday Party, as well as monthly member-hosted Sunday socials. You won't want to miss out!

Do you have a clubhouse where members can host a party?

Yes, we offer clubhouse rental by the hour for your personal events. The clubhouse interior is 1,600 sq ft and features additional outdoor deck space that is also available for parties.

Are dogs allowed on property?

No, sorry, but your furry friends need to stay home!
